

## **II. ANALYSIS OF REGISTERED PUBLICATIONS**

**2.1.1.** The number of publications registered with the Registrar of Newspapers for India has maintained a rising trend. There were 99,660 registered publications as on 31-03-2014. A total number of 5,817 new publications were registered and 34 publications were ceased during the period from 01-04-2014 to 31-03-2015 thereby raising the total numbers as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2015 to 1,05,443 showing a net increase of 5.80 per cent above that of the previous year (Table 2.1).

**2.1.2.** There were 14,573 registered dailies and 411 tri/bi-weeklies in 2014-15, as against 13,350 dailies and 411 tri and bi weeklies in 2013-14. Total number of dailies, taken together with tri/bi-weeklies, has increased by 1,223 or 8.89 per cent during the reporting year. (Table 2.1)

**2.1.3.** State-wise analysis reveals that there has been an increase in the number of publications in all States and Union Territories except Nagaland and Lakshadweep. (Table 2.4)

**2.1.4.** The pattern of growth of publications in the country during the last five years is given in Table 2.1 It reveals a growth of **5.80** per cent in the total number of publications published in the country over the previous year.

### **PROFILE OF NEW PUBLICATIONS**

**2.2.1.** Out of 5,817 publications registered during the period 2014-15, 1,230 were dailies, 1,831 weeklies, 582 fortnightlies, 1,803 monthlies, 205 quarterlies, 31 annuals and 135 of other periodicities. (Table 2.2)

**2.2.2.** In 2014-15, new publications were registered in all the main languages except Bodo, Dogri, Kashmiri, and Sindhi. The largest numbers, 2,349 were brought out and registered in Hindi, followed by 666 in Marathi and 533 in English. (Table 2.2)

### **CEASED PUBLICATIONS**

**2.3.** A total number of 34 registered publications were ceased their publications during the period 2014-15. These include 10 publications in Delhi, 07 in U.P., 06 in Maharashtra, 03 each in Rajasthan & West Bengal, 01 each in Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Kerala, J&K and Gujarat. Language-wise & Periodicity-wise break-up of such publications are as follows:- 06 dailies, 04 weeklies, 03 monthlies, 01 fortnightly and 01 Bi-monthly in Hindi, 03 monthlies, 02 each of weeklies, fortnightlies and bi-monthlies and 01 quarterly in English, 02 weeklies and 01 bi-monthly in Marathi, 01 each of daily, weekly and monthly in Bengali, 01 weekly and 01 monthly in Bi-lingual, 01 monthly in Multi-lingual.

## DAILIES

**2.4.1.** The total number of daily publications in 2014-15 increased to 14,573 as compared to previous year's 13,350 i.e. an increase by 1223 in numbers or 9.16 in percentage terms. Daily publications were brought out in almost all main languages of the country. Hindi dailies topped the list with 6,297. Other languages in which more than 100 daily publications were brought out were (i) Urdu (1,635), (ii) English (1,209), (iii) Telugu (1,193), (iv) Marathi (1,037), (v) Kannada (755), (vi) Gujarati (539), (vii) Tamil (467), (viii) Malayalam (344), (ix) Bilingual (316) (x) Bengali (184) (xi) Oriya (171) and (xii) Punjabi (166). (Table 2.3)

**2.4.2.** Tri or bi-weekly publications, which are akin to dailies in dissemination of news, totaled 411 with Hindi at the top with 131 followed by English (62), Tamil (46), Marathi (25), Bilingual (23), Gujarati (19), Bengali (19) Urdu (16), and Punjabi (16). (Table 2.3)

## PERIODICALS

**2.5.** A total of 90,459 publications of various periodicities other than dailies and tri/bi-weeklies were on the records of the RNI in 2014-15. Out of these, 34,991 were weeklies, 32,278 monthlies, 12,747 fortnightlies, 5,994 quarterlies and 798 annuals. There were 3,651 publications of other periodicities such as bi-monthly, tri-monthly, half-yearly etc. Weeklies and monthlies appeared to be more popular, with their total number soaring to 67,269 accounting for 74.36% approx. of the total periodicals. (Table 2.3)

## LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

**2.6.1.** Language wise analysis of registered publications shows that publications were registered in 172 languages and dialects in 2014-15. Apart from English and 22 other principal languages, listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution, publications were registered in 149 other languages or dialects, mostly Indian and also in a few foreign languages. (Appendix II).

**2.6.2.** In 2014-15 also, the same trend can be noticed from the data of previous years that the highest number (42,493) of publications were registered in Hindi followed by English (13,661), Marathi (7,818), Gujarati (4,836), Urdu (4,770), Kannada (4,513), Telugu (4,311), Tamil (4,091), Bengali (3,855) and Malayalam (2,477). (Table 2.3)

**2.6.3.** Apart from periodicals, published in one language, there were a significant number of publications brought out in two or more languages categorized as 'bilingual' and 'multilingual'. At the end of 2014-15, there were 7,282 'Bilingual' and 1,186 'Multilingual' publications. (Table 2.3)

## STATE-WISE ANALYSIS

**2.7.1.** Uttar Pradesh with 16,130 registered publications retained its top position at the end of 2014-15. Maharashtra with 14,394 publications came next, followed by Delhi with (12,177), Madhya Pradesh (8,932), Andhra Pradesh (6,215), Rajasthan (6,045), Karnataka (5,922), Tamil Nadu (5,820), Gujarat (5,262), West Bengal (5,188), Uttarakhand (3,179), Kerala (3,145), Orissa (1,909), Bihar (1,858) Punjab (1,830), Haryana (1,690), Chhattisgarh (1,382), and J&K (1,003) were among other states having more than 1000 publications registered. (Table 2.4)

**2.7.2.** In the category of dailies also, Uttar Pradesh maintained its lead, with 2,936 daily publications followed by Andhra Pradesh (1,598), Maharashtra (1,493), Madhya Pradesh (1,158), Delhi (1,040), Karnataka (941), Rajasthan (794), Gujarat (630), Tamil Nadu (519), Bihar (499), Uttarakhand (363), Kerala (357) and J&K (307). States having the publication of 200 or more dailies were West Bengal (287), Chhattisgarh (264), Punjab (261), Orissa (225) and Haryana (210). Dailies were published from almost all States and Union Territories except Lakshadweep. (Table 2.4)

**2.7.3.** In 2014-15, nearly 74.36 per cent of periodicals were weeklies or monthlies. The largest number of weeklies were published from Uttar Pradesh (8,071), followed by Maharashtra (6,434), Madhya Pradesh (3,789), Delhi (2,367), Gujarat (2,303) Uttarakhand (1,872) Rajasthan (1,512) Karnataka (1,159) and Andhra Pradesh (1,133). States publishing more than 500 weeklies were West Bengal (960), Tamil Nadu (774), Bihar (688), Punjab (636), Haryana (578) and Chhattisgarh (538). (Table 2.4)

**2.7.4.** The largest numbers of monthlies were published from Delhi (5,099), followed by Maharashtra (3,612), Tamil Nadu (3,288), Madhya Pradesh (3,056), Uttar Pradesh (2,727), Karnataka (2,403), Andhra Pradesh (2,377), Kerala (1,803), West Bengal (1,549), Gujarat (1,448), and Rajasthan (1,140). States from where more than 500 Monthlies were brought out were Orissa (651), and Punjab (553). (Table 2.4)

**2.7.5.** Odisha had the distinction of having publications in 20 out of 23 principal languages (including English). Maharashtra & Delhi came next with publications in 19 & 17 languages respectively, followed by Andhra Pradesh & Tamil Nadu with 15 languages in each State. (Table 2.5)

**2.7.6.** The distinction for bringing out the highest number of publications in a single language went to Uttar Pradesh from where 12,923 publications were brought out in Hindi. Other states with over 2000 publications in Hindi were Madhya Pradesh (8,194), Delhi (5,277), Rajasthan (5,346) and Uttarakhand (2,762). More than 2000 publications in a single language were published from (i) Maharashtra (7,680) in Marathi and (2,461) in English (ii) Gujarat (4,422) in Gujarati, (iii) Karnataka (4,419) in Kannada, (iv) Delhi (4,039) in English, (v) Andhra Pradesh (4,038) in Telugu (vi) Tamil Nadu (3,842) in Tamil, (vii) West Bengal (3,511) in Bengali, (viii) Kerala (2,319) in Malayalam. (Table 2.5)

## CONCENTRATION

**2.8.** The Print Media tends to concentrate in certain important cities and towns, giving them eminence as major printing and publishing hubs, which can be classified as under:

- (i) Metropolitan Cities (Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai),
- (ii) State Capitals (other than the Metropolitan Cities),
- (iii) Union Territories,
- (iv) Big Cities, (having a population of more than 1,00,000)
- (v) Small Towns. (having a population of less than 1,00,000)

## NUMERICAL ANALYSIS

**2.9.1.** At the end of 2014-15, the total numbers of publications registered from the four Metropolitan Cities were 28,199 accounting for 26.74 per cent of the all India total. State capitals were publishing 21,461 registered publications or 20.35 per cent of the total. Big cities published a total of 40,294 publications constituting 38.21 per cent. As many as 1,060 publications were brought out from small towns constituting 10.48 per cent of the total numbers where as the Union Territories accounted for the remaining 4.22 per cent (approx). (Table 2.6)

**2.9.2.** Out of 14,573 dailies, a total number of 1,916 dailies were being brought out from the Metropolitan Cities and 2,641 from State Capitals. The Big Cities in various States published 7,345 daily publications and the Small Towns brought out 1,514. The Union Territories published only 1,157 dailies (Table 2.7).

## LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

**2.10.** Out of the total 13,661 publications in English language, 7,323 (53.61 per cent) were brought out from the four metropolitan cities. Other languages in which a large number of publications were brought out from the metropolitan cities were in Hindi, Tamil, Bengali, Urdu and Marathi. It was noticed that the Metropolitan-City, Delhi had a sizeable number of publications in Hindi while other main centers of Hindi publications were Big Cities and Small Towns other than State Capitals. Publications in Hindi and English were mainly published from State Capitals. Publications of Hindi, Marathi, English, Gujarati, Telugu and Bengali as well as Bilingual publications were centered in Big Cities. (Table 2.6)

## LONGEVITY

**2.12. BOMBAY SAMACHAR**, a Gujarati daily, being published since 1822 from Mumbai was the oldest among existing publications in India. The 48 centenarians of the Indian Press including the Bombay Samachar are as under:




