

## **CHAPTER – 3**

### **PUBLICATIONS WHICH FILED ANNUAL STATEMENT FOR 2015-16**

**3.1.** Under Section 19(D) of the PRB Act, 1867, it is mandatory for every registered publication to submit an Annual Statement to the Office of the Registrar of Newspapers for India. The Annual Statements sent by them are the principal source of data for the compilation of the Annual Report of the Registrar of Newspapers for India called “PRESS IN INDIA” The RNI has taken steps to facilitate the process of filing of the Annual Statements by the publishers and an online system of e-filing of Annual Statements has been put in place on our website. However, it is observed that not all the publishers are submitting their Annual Statements. Non-compliance with the above provision of the Act by publishers has so far precluded this office from claiming this report to be a comprehensive data bank of the print media in India. However, in order to make this report a more meaningful document with authentic statistical information, the Annual Statements received from the publishers online for the year 2015-16 have only been taken into account in this chapter. Out of 1,10,851 registered newspapers & periodicals, as many as 26,104 submitted their Annual Reports online. The chapter gives a general trend in the Print Media in the country on the basis of various parameters such as – Periodicity, Language, State, City, Small Town-wise, etc.

#### **DAILIES**

**3.2.1.** During the year 2015-16, as many as 8,905 Daily publications submitted their Annual Statements. These were being brought out in all the languages listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution except Bodo. Among the Dailies, Hindi retained its top position in the list with 4,118 Dailies while other languages with more than 200 Dailies are (i) Urdu (1,268), (ii) Telugu (856), (iii) English (836), (iv) Marathi, (423), (v) Gujarati (421) and (vi) Kannada (229). (Table 3.1)

**3.2.2.** Apart from Dailies, Tri-Weekly and Bi-Weekly publications also play an important role in dissemination of information/news to keep the readers abreast of the latest happenings/events within and outside the country. In this category, Annual Statements were received from 9 publications of different languages. (Table 3.1)

#### **PERIODICALS**

**3.3.** A total number of 17,190 publications of various periodicities (except Dailies & Tri/Bi Weeklies) submitted their Annual Statements for 2015-16. Out of these, 9,295 were Weeklies; 4,672 Monthlies; 2,524 Fortnightlies; 347 Quarterlies and 80 Annuals. There were 272 Periodicals i.e. Bi-Monthly, Half-yearly etc., which are categorized as other periodicities. The Weeklies and Monthlies with their total number at 13,967 appeared to be more popular, accounting for nearly 53.50 per cent of the total periodicals. (Table 3.1)

## LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

**3.4.1.** As per the circulation data available, publications were brought out in 42 languages and dialects in 2015-16. Apart from English and other principal languages, listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution, publications were also published in 25 other languages or dialects mostly Indian and a few foreign languages. Other languages in which publications came out were Arabic, Bhojpuri, Bodo, Garo, Garhwali, Halbi, Italian, Karbi, Khasi, Kokborok, Meeteilon, Mizo Lushai, Nagamese, Prakrit, Rajasthani, Sinhali, Tenyidie and Tulu.

**3.4.2.** Among the publications of different languages which had submitted their Annual Statements during 2015-16, the highest number of publications were in Hindi (14,316) followed by English (2,174), Urdu (1,891), Gujarati (1,638), Telugu (1,596), Marathi (1,182), Kannada (450), Odia (361), Bengali (359), Tamil (328) and Malayalam (259) etc. (Table 3.1)

**3.4.3.** Apart from publications brought out in one language, there were also quite a number of publications which were brought out in two or more languages in the same issue. Such publications were categorized as 'Bi-lingual' and 'Multi-lingual'. There were 1,121 'Bilingual' and 101 'Multilingual' publications in the country.

## STATE-WISE ANALYSIS

**3.5.1.** Uttar Pradesh with 6,083 publications filing their online Annual Statements in 2015-16 retained its top position among the states. Madhya Pradesh with (3,308) publications came next followed by Delhi (2,583); Uttarakhand (1,966); Maharashtra (1,923); Gujarat (1,790); Rajasthan (1,725) and Andhra Pradesh (1,523). Other States from where more than 300 publications filed their online Annual Statements were Telangana (621); Karnataka (605); Tamil Nadu (516); West Bengal (483); Odisha (451); Chhattisgarh (406); J & K (387) and Kerala (304). (Table 3.2)

**3.5.2.** In the category of Dailies also, Uttar Pradesh maintained its lead with 2,316 Daily publications followed by Andhra Pradesh (832), Madhya Pradesh (798); Delhi (717); Maharashtra (617); Gujarat (503) and Rajasthan (466); Daily newspapers were published from almost all the States and Union Territories except Lakshadweep. (Table 3.2)

**3.5.3.** About 53.50 per cent of the periodicals being published were Weeklies and Monthlies. Out of 17,190 periodicals, about 35.61 per cent were held by Weeklies only. The largest number of Weeklies were being published from Uttar Pradesh (2,794); followed by Uttarakhand (1,334); Madhya Pradesh (1,082); Maharashtra (908); Gujarat (904); Delhi (677) and Rajasthan (370). (Table 3.2)

**3.5.4.** About 17.90 per cent of the total numbers of periodicals being published were Monthlies. The largest number of Monthlies were published from Madhya Pradesh (1,178) followed by Delhi (722); Uttar Pradesh (578); Andhra Pradesh (414) and Maharashtra (244).

Other states publishing more than 150 Monthlies were Tamil Nadu (172); Uttarakhand (168); Gujarat (164) and Rajasthan (155). (Table 3.2)

**3.5.5.** Delhi brought out publications in 18 languages followed by Maharashtra in 16 languages; Karnataka and Tamil Nadu in 12 languages each; Gujarat, Uttarakhand and West Bengal in 11 languages each; Puducherry in 10 languages; out of 23 main languages (including English) listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution. (Table 3.3)

**3.5.6.** The distinction for bringing out the highest number of publications in a single language went to Uttar Pradesh, where 4,806 publications were brought out in Hindi. The other states with over 500 publications in Hindi were Madhya Pradesh (3,096); Uttarakhand (1,795); Rajasthan (1,564) and Delhi (1,475). (Table 3.3)

**3.5.7.** States with more than 300 publications in a single language were (i) Delhi (Hindi 1,475) and (English 517); (ii) Andhra Pradesh (Telugu 1,212); (iii) Gujarat (Gujarati 1,576); (iv) Maharashtra (Marathi 1,152); (v) Uttar Pradesh (Hindi 4,806) and Urdu (896); (vi) Madhya Pradesh (Hindi 3,096); (vii) Uttarakhand (Hindi 1,795); (viii) Odisha (Odia 355); (ix) Telangana (Telugu 369); (x) Karnataka (Kannada 438) and (xi) Rajasthan (Hindi 1,564). (Table 3.3)

## CONCENTRATION

**3.6.** The Print Media tends to concentrate in certain important Cities and Towns, giving them prominence as major printing and publishing centers, which can be classified as under:

- (i) Big Cities (having a population of more than 1,00,000),
- (ii) Metropolitan Cities (Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai),
- (iii) State Capitals (other than the Metropolitan Cities),
- (iv) Small Towns (having a population of less than 1,00,000) and
- (v) Union Territories.

## LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

**3.7.** Among those publications, which submitted their Annual Statements online during 2015-16, Language wise analysis of publications shows that out of 14,316 Hindi publications, 5,786 were brought out from the State Capitals, 5,090 from the Big Cities 1,770 from the Small Towns, 1,614 from Metropolitan Cities and 56 from Union Territories. Out of 2,174 publications in English, 842 were brought out from the four Metropolitan Cities. The other languages in which a large number of publications came out from the Metropolitan Cities were Hindi (1,614); English (842), Urdu (293); and Marathi (133). The four Metropolitan Cities published 317 bilingual and 19 multilingual publications. (Table 3.4)

### NUMERICAL ANALYSIS

**3.8.1.** The total number of publications brought out from the four Metropolitan Cities during 2015-16 was 3,592 accounting for 13.76 per cent of the total publications. State Capitals (excluding the Metropolitan Cities) published 8,503 publications constituting 32.57 percent of the total. Big Cities published a total of 10,816 publications constituting 41.43 percent. Thus, the Big Cities dominated the number of publications in India in 2015-16. A total of 2,996 publications came out from Small Towns and 197 from Union Territory. (Table 3.5)

**3.8.2.** Out of 8,905 Dailies, a total of 973 were being published from the Metropolitan Cities and 2,687 from the State Capitals. The Big Cities in various States published 4,118 Dailies and Small Towns brought out 1,018 Daily newspapers. The Union Territories published only 109 Dailies. (Table 3.5)
