CHAPTER - 3

PUBLICATIONS WHICH FILED ANNUAL STATEMENT FOR 2021-2022

3.1. Under Section 19(D) of the PRB Act, 1867, it is mandatory for every registered publication to submit an Annual Statement to the Office of the Registrar of Newspapers for India. The Annual Statements are the principal source of data for compilation of the Annual Report of the Registrar of Newspapers for India called "Press in India". RNI has taken steps to facilitate the process of filing of the Annual Statements by publishers and an online system of e-filing of Annual Statements has been put in place on our website. However, it is observed that not all the publishers are submitting their Annual Statements. Non-compliance with the above provision of the Act by publishers has so far precluded this office from claiming this report to be a comprehensive data bank of the print media in India. However, in order to make this report a more meaningful document with authentic statistical information, the Annual Statements received online from the publishers for the year 2021-2022 have only been taken into account in this chapter. Out of 1,46,045 registered newspapers & periodicals as many as 34,148 submitted their Annual Statements including 221 publications of Miscellaneous classification. The chapter depicts a general trend in Print Media in the country on the basis of various parameters such as – Periodicity, Language, State, City, Small Town, etc.

DAILIES

3.2. During the year 2021-2022, as many as 10,038 daily publications submitted their Annual Statements. These were being brought out in all the languages listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution. Among the dailies, Hindi retained its top position in the list with 4,424 Dailies while other languages with more than 200 Dailies are: (i) Urdu (1,107); (ii) Telugu (1,065); (iii) English (825); (iv) Marathi (697); (v) Kannada (651); and (vi) Gujarati (401). (Table 3.1)

PERIODICALS

3.3. A total number of 23,889 publications of various periodicities (except Dailies) submitted their Annual Statements for 2021-2022. Out of these, 11,616 were Weeklies; 7,799 Monthlies; 3,133 Fortnightlies; 766 Quarterlies and 122 Annuals. There are 453 periodicals, i.e. Bi-Monthly, Half-Yearly etc., which are categorised as other periodicities. Weeklies and Monthlies with their total number at 19,415 appeared to be more popular, accounting for nearly 57.23 percent of the total periodicals. (*Table 3.1*)

LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.4.1. As per the circulation data available, publications were brought out in 51 languages and dialects in 2021-2022. Apart from English and other principal languages, listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution, publications were also published in 22 other languages or dialects, mostly Indian and a few foreign languages. Other languages in which publications published were: Ao Naga, Arabic, Bhojpuri, Chhattisgarhi, Sindhi Devnagri, Garo, Garhwali, Halbi, Karbi, Khasi, Khortha, Kharia, Kokborok, Meeteilon, Mizo Lushai, Naga, Nagpuri, Rajasthani, Santhali, Tenyidie and Tulu.

- **3.4.2.** Among the publications of different languages which submitted their Annual Statements during 2021-2022, the highest number of publications were in Hindi (16,793) followed by Marathi (2,807); English (2,485); Telugu (2,248); Gujarati (2,028); Urdu (1,701); Kannada (1,300); Tamil (869); Bengali (551); Odia (446); Malayalam (346) etc. (*Table 3.1*)
- **3.4.3.** Apart from publications brought out in one language, there were also quite a number of publications which were brought out in two or more languages in the same issue. Such publications were categorised as 'Bi-lingual' and 'Multi-lingual'. There were 1,706 'Bilingual' and 236 'Multilingual' publications in the country. (*Table 3.1*)

STATE-WISE ANALYSIS

- **3.5.1.** Uttar Pradesh, with 6,051 publications filing their online Annual Statements in 2021-2022, retained its top position among the States. Madhya Pradesh with (5,620) publications came next; followed by Maharashtra (4,278); Gujarat (2,269); Delhi (2,206); Andhra Pradesh (1,985); Uttarakhand (1,899); Rajasthan (1,704); Karnataka (1,508) and Tamil Nadu (1,157). Other States/UTs from where more than 300 publications filed their online Annual Statements were Telangana (861); West Bengal (674); Chhattisgarh (574); Odisha (543); Kerala (456); J & K (410); Haryana (372) and Punjab (316). (*Table 3.2*)
- **3.5.2.** In the category of dailies also, Uttar Pradesh maintained its lead with 2,197 Daily publications followed by Madhya Pradesh (1,250); Maharashtra (955); Andhra Pradesh (934); Karnataka (722); Delhi (568); Gujarat (507); Telangana (429); and Rajasthan (432). Daily newspapers were published from all the States and Union Territories. *(Table 3.2)*
- **3.5.3.** About 57.23 percent of the periodicals being published were either Weeklies or Monthlies. Out of 23,889 periodicals (except dailies), about 48.61 percent were Weeklies only. The largest number of Weeklies were published from Uttar Pradesh (2,730); followed by Maharashtra (2,368); Madhya Pradesh (1,622); Uttarakhand (1,277); Gujarat (1,128); Delhi (492); Rajasthan (353) and Karnataka (186). (*Table 3.2*)
- **3.5.4.** About 22.98 percent of the total number of periodicals being published were Monthlies. The largest number of Monthlies were published from Madhya Pradesh (2,203) followed by Uttar Pradesh (720); Andhra Pradesh (695); Delhi (680) and Tamil Nadu (655). Other states publishing more than 200 monthlies were Maharashtra (565); Karnataka (351); Gujarat (306); and Telangana (251). (*Table 3.2*)
- **3.5.5.**Delhi brought out publications in 18 languages followed by: Maharashtra, Uttarakhand and Tamil Nadu in 17 languages each; Karnataka in 15 languages; Gujarat 14; Kerala 13; West Bengal in 12 languages; Punjab & Puducherry in 10 languages; Assam, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh in 9 languages each; Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and Madhya Pradesh in 8 languages each; Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir, Odisha and Telangana in 6 languages each; out of 24 main languages (excluding English) listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution. (*Table 3.3*)
- **3.5.6.** The distinction for bringing out the highest number of publications in a single language went to Madhya Pradesh, where 5,258 publications were brought out in Hindi. The other states with over 500 publications in Hindi were Uttar Pradesh (4,860); Uttarakhand (1,722); Rajasthan (1,541); Delhi (1,159) and Maharashtra (575). (*Table 3.3*)

3.5.7. States with more than 200 publications in a single language were (i) Delhi (Hindi 1,159) and (English 532); (ii) Andhra Pradesh (Telugu 1,663); (iii) Gujarat (Gujarati 1,937); (iv) Maharashtra (Marathi 2,754), (Hindi 575) and English (368); (v) Uttar Pradesh (Hindi 4,860) and Urdu (757); (vi) West Bengal (Bengali 472); (vii) Tamil Nadu (Tamil 804); (viii) Odisha (Odia 430); (ix) Kerala (Malayalam 327); (x) Karnataka (Kannada 1,275); (xi) Chhattisgarh (Hindi 524); (xii) Haryana (Hindi 316); (xiii) Madhya Pradesh (Hindi 5,258); (xiv) Telangana (Tamil 558)(Telugu 148); (xv) Uttarakhand (Hindi 1,722); (xvi) Rajasthan (Hindi 1,541). (*Table 3.3*)

CONCENTRATION

- **3.6.** The Print Media tends to concentrate in certain important cities and towns, giving them prominence as major printing and publishing centers, which can be classified as under:
 - (i) Metropolitan Cities (Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai, Chennai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Ahmedabad, Pune, Jaipur, Surat, Nagpur, Visakhapatnam and Amravati);
 - (ii) State Capitals;
 - (iii) Union Territories;
 - (iv) Big Cities, (having a population of more than 1,00,000); and
 - (v) Small Towns (having a population of less than 1,00,000).

LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.7. Among those publications, which submitted their Annual Statements online during 2021-2022, Language-wise analysis of publications shows that out of 25,813 Hindi publications, 13,050 were brought out from Big Cities; 8,803 were brought out from the State Capitals; 2,295 from the four Metropolitan Cities; 1,266 from the Union Territories and 399 from the Smaller Towns. Out of 5,809 publications in English, 2,060 were brought out from Big Cities. The other languages in which a large number of publications were brought out from the Metropolitan Cities were Hindi (2,295); English (1,243); Marathi (686); Gujarati (674); Tamil (555); Telugu (374); and Urdu (381). 13 metropolitan cities brought out 642 Bilingual and 77 Multilingual publications. (*Table 3.4*)

NUMERICAL ANALYSIS

3.8.1. The total number of publications brought out from the 13 metropolitan cities during 2021-2022 were 7,277 accounting for 14.38 percent of the total publications. State Capitals (excluding the Metropolitan Cities) published 14,050 publications constituting 28.00 percent of the total. Big cities published a total of 25,061 publications constituting 49.93 percent of the total, thus dominating the number of publications in India in 2021-2022. A total of 2,762 publications came out from Union Territories and 1,034 from Small Towns. (*Table 3.5*)

3.8.2. Out of 13,979 dailies, a total of 1,813 were being published from the Metropolitan Cities and 3,702 from the State Capitals. The Big cities in various States published 7,220 dailies and Union Territories brought out 896 Daily Newspapers. The Small Towns published only 348 Dailies. *(Table 3.5)*
